The following project is also associated with materials, designs and prints for projects #07 Pot Holder and #09 Window Curtains & Cafe Curtains. Designs for this project can be printed with either the Stamp Kit for Cloth or screen printed using RISO ScreenMaster.



### HOW TO MAKE PLACEMATS

#### Equipment

- PRINT GOCCO PG-5, PG-11, B6 or PG Screen Printing Kit
- PRINT GOCCO Hand Stamper Unit (S-112 or S-113)
- Stamp Inks for Cloth in desired colours
- 1 x B6 Print Master (S-489)
- 2 x Print Lamps (S-105)

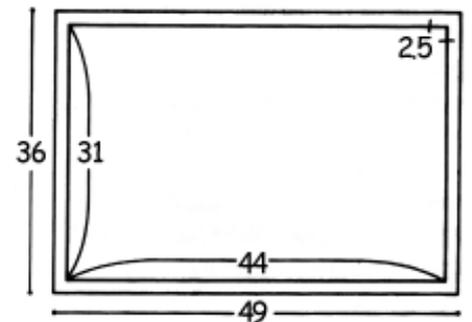
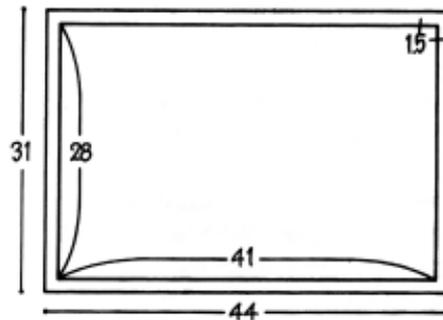
#### Materials

- White cotton material 310mm x 440mm
- Red spotted cotton material 360mm x 490mm

#### Method

##### Step 1

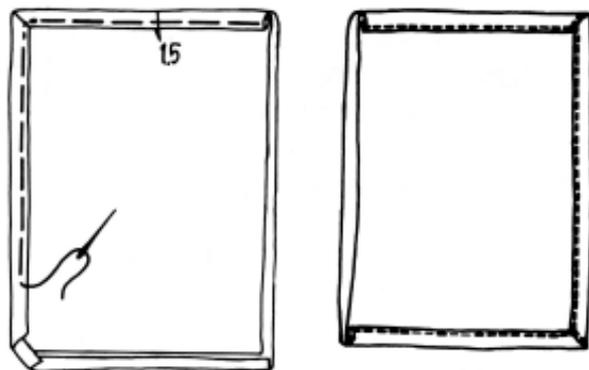
Cut the material to size.  
Print your design around the edges of the white cotton.



##### How to print your designs

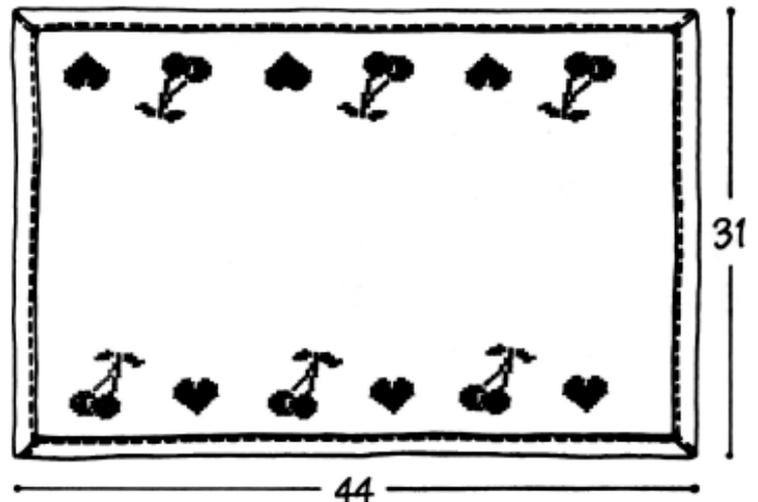

##### Step 2

Place the front and back together, as shown left.  
Tack them, leaving a border of 1.5cm.



##### Step 3

Machine stitch the border, making sure to stitch the corners completely.
